X-ray on Display

MARCONI Instruments now have two excellently equipped showrooms, at St. Albans and Marconi House, Strand, where a wide range of X-ray and electromedical equipment is permanently on display.

Much of the equipment shown is fully operational and includes surgical diathermies, pure-tone audiometers for the determination of hearing acuity, multichannel electro-encephalographs for the recording of brain potentials, high-voltage deep therapy X-ray apparatus and diagnostic X-ray units both static and mobile.

Among the many interesting exhibits is the electro-cardiograph, which records heart pulses in the form of a trace on a paper tape.

Marconi Instruments X-ray and electro-medical equipment is being increasingly used in hospitals in Britain and abroad. Typical of the Company's progressive policy is the adaptation of Deep Therapy X-ray apparatus to
